

For pupils in Year 3 to 6, children will have been issued with a meldreth.education Google Classroom account.

For pupils in Year R, 1 and 2, we will be emailing you your account details shortly to use to log into Google and join the meetings.


## **Getting started with Google Meet**

### **Before using Google Meet**

- Please use Google Chrome as your browser
- Go to google.com
- Click on the 'sign In' button in the top right of the screen
- You must log in to Google using your child's meldreth.education Gmail account.

### Joining your meeting in Key Stage 2

- When it is time for your meeting, your child should go to their Google Classroom stream, click on the link at the top of the page, and click "ask to join."
- When your teacher is ready, they will accept your request and you will be connected.



### Joining your meeting in Puffin, Swift or Wren class

- When it is time for your meeting, please click on the link provided by your child's class teacher (or copy this into your web browser), and click "ask to join."
- When your teacher is ready, they will accept your request and you will be connected with your teacher.

# **Our Expectations for Pupils**

Your child should always access live lessons in a shared space in your house, rather than in their bedroom. You will need a device, which can access the internet including chrome books, iPads, laptops, phones or even your Xbox or Playstation. Details of how to do this can be found <u>here</u>.

#### We ask that:

- Your child sits against a neutral background or wall if possible.
- Parents are mindful that other children might see or hear them and anything in the background.
- Children are dressed for the day no pyjamas!
- You ensure that your camera is off if you do not wish your child to be seen.
- Pupils join meetings on mute until they wish to ask a question.
