## Punctuation

<b>ABC</b>	<b>Capital letters</b> for the start of sentences, names and places.
<b>.</b>	A <b>full stop</b> at the end of a sentence.
<b>!</b>	<b>Exclamation marks</b> for exclamation or surprise.
<b>?</b>	<b>Question marks</b> for questions.
<b>'</b>	<b>Apostrophes</b> for showing something belongs to someone and to mark missing letters in contractions (didn't)
<b>,</b>	<b>Commas</b> to separate items in a list and before a conjunction.
<b>“ ”</b>	<b>Inverted commas</b> to show direct speech.
