Our monitoring has also identified this. Last year we worked with a focus group of parents to develop support pages on our website (accessed [here](#).) We communicate what is going on in your child's class on Starz class pages. These can be accessed using your child's Starz login. We will continue to offer this support and review the way we communicate what is happening in your child's class.

You said

" Teachers need to identify areas for improvement even for those children who are doing well."

This is important to us too, we believe that more able pupils should be given the opportunity to study subjects to a greater breadth and depth. In class we give feedback to all pupils to develop their next steps in learning. We aim to provide going deeper opportunities for pupils in order to develop pupil's specific skills and talents.

"Clear communication provided at parent's evenings with follow up meetings organised if required. Frequent opportunities provided by the school to 'find out more' if you want to - e.g. 'classroom drop-in', 'bedtime story event'. At the start of the year I valued the session and hand-outs provided that set out the learning objectives for the forthcoming year - these were pitched extremely well."
