
MAGNIFICENT MATHS - making equal groups



Let's do this one together.

Beach ball nets hold 3 balls.

Group the balls in 3's to find out how many nets are needed.



The beach ball nets hold 3 balls each. We find out how many nets we need by circling three beach balls at a time and putting them in to equal groups.

Look at how I have circled each set of 3 beach balls with a clear line.

There are 3 groups of 3 balls so that means that we need 3 beach ball nets.

Try this on your own copy of the picture and then complete the rest of the making equal group problems.

Make sure you count each group of objects accurately before you circle them to make a group.
