

Dinner Money Matters

Dinner money is payable on the first day of the week – normally this is Monday – even if your child only has a school dinner on Thursdays. At the moment they are £2.30 per day, £11.50 per week and these must be paid in advance. Families of pupils whose dinner money debt rises above £10 will be asked to send in packed lunches until a positive balance is restored. Rest assured, children who forget to bring their packed lunch to school will be provided with a school dinner, and payment can be made at a later date.

Attendance at school

As you are aware, schools have strict guidelines to follow when dealing with non-attendance. **Holidays taken in term time will not be authorised** unless there are exceptional circumstances. Every day in school, or a trip away from school, is carefully planned to ensure all our children develop the knowledge, understanding, skills & experiences to flourish. In missing school time children not only miss key learning but then have to ensure they have caught up on what has been missed.
