Maths - newspaper numbers

You need- a pen, paper, three buckets, large bowls or washing baskets, newspaper

Write numbers 1, 2, 3 on three pieces of paper and put them in front of the buckets.

Create six balls of newspaper (can anyone scrunch it using just one hand?!)

Throw the balls into the buckets, write down which bucket they land in eg 2, 2, 1, 1, 3, 2

1. Add the numbers together.
2. What's the largest number you could score?
3. Who scores the most?
4. Move the buckets further away- can you still score points?
