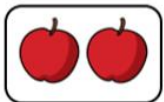
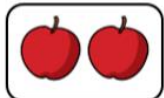
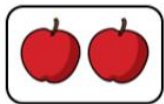

Can you find arrays in your house? You could look at lego/duplo bricks, egg boxes or baking trays.

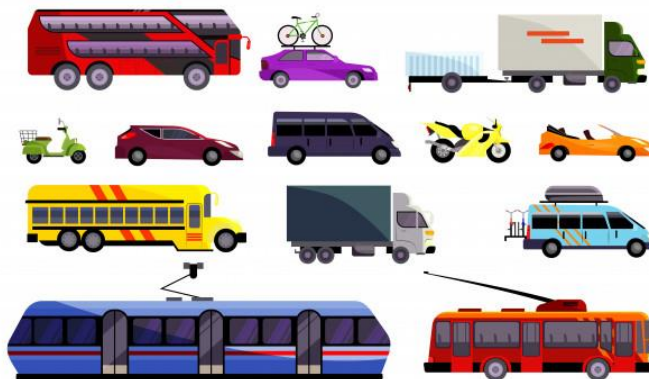

RE activity

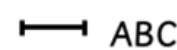

Play the 'ur sound family game' (attached)

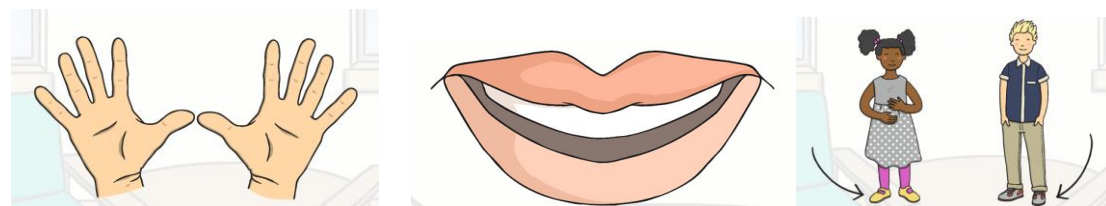
