Light and Dark

Introduction

This 'Light and Dark' unit will teach your class about the importance of light to many in Christianity, Hinduism and Judaism through learning about Advent, Christmas, Diwali and Hanukkah. Children learn how and whu light can be important to each festival through participating in lots of practical and creative activities. Children then go on to think about what light and darkness can represent and symbolise in each religion. Towards the end of the unit children will begin to make simple links and comparisons between the different religions.



Health & Safety

Ensure that there is adequate adult supervision and guidance when children are making their diva lamps in Lesson 3, and if the lamps are lit in Lesson 4. Also ensure that any relevant school policies, including those regarding food allergies, are followed if children take part in any of the food/drink preparation activities mentioned in the Taskit sections.



Home Learning

Light: In this task, children will make a poster to show what the word 'light' means to them.

Take Six: In this task, children will take photos of three things which remind them of or represent light and three things which remind them of or represent the dark.
