



# Blooming Marvellous!



*Entry Point: After reading Yucky Worms, we will make our own worm house. We will be writing diary entries every week in order to report on what we see happening.*

English	<p><i>We will explore and write a variety of poems. We will develop writing skills for simple riddles (Who am I?) and free verse.</i></p> <p><i>We will introduce singular and plural - bush / bushes.</i></p> <p><i>We will begin to spell words using -ed, ing, er and -est and we will use the prefix un-.</i></p> <p><i>We will continue to develop our skills in writing instructions and fact files.</i></p> <p><i>In phonics we will be consolidating our learning for the alternative sounds used for 'c' and 'g'. We will be learning GPC's for: ire, are, tch, oe, ph and revisiting long vowel sounds for a, e, i, o and u.</i></p>
Maths	<p><i>We will be finishing our measure unit, specifically looking at capacity and volume. We will be covering sharing (division) and fractions for this half term. We will recognise, find and name a half as two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. We will recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.</i></p>
Science	<p><i>We will be completing our unit on plants as well as begin looking at seasonal changes that take place during spring and summer.</i></p> <p><i>Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.</i></p> <p><i>Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.</i></p> <p><i>Identify and recognise seasonal changes - spring in to summer.</i></p>





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Art	<i>We will be focusing on the land artist Andy Goldsworthy, exploring and creating patterns using a variety of natural materials. We will continue to develop our use of colour and texture by painting our own version of one of Andy's pieces of work.</i>

RE	<i>Stories and symbols, thinking about key stories in various religions.</i>
Music	<i>Our unit is called Having Fun with Improvisation. We will be using a variety of instruments to explore creating melodies and rhythms individually as well as with a partner and as part of a group.</i>
Computing	<i>We will use Purple Mash learn to develop the children's coding skills.</i>
PE	<i>This half term we will be completing our skipping week challenges along with our fundamentals and athletics units.</i>
Geography	<i>At the farm - We will be exploring farms and why they are important. We will be exploring the features of a farm and will be using maps and symbols to navigate our way around a farm. We will be looking at how seasons affect farms and we will be comparing farm life with that of people living in a town.</i>
