Morning activities: This is our first activity of the day. We usually complete these independently. Choose one to do for each morning.

Reading Corner - Please try to read every day. Here are some activities you might like to complete.

1. Design a poster for the book you have read to encourage other people to read it.
2. Write speech bubbles for the main characters in your story. What would they say?
3. Which character from the story would you most like to be and why?
4. Were there any words in your book that you didn't know the meaning of? Find out what they mean.



Topic/Writing activities for this week: Our topic this half term is Superheroes. We will be using the story Supertato for our learning.

1. Free Write - Use the picture at the bottom of the signpost to write sentences about what you see or write a story using the picture as inspiration.
2. **Superheroes!** What is a superhero? What is a supervillain? Where might you have seen them before? Watch Supertato - Veggies Assemble on Books Alive using this [link](#). What superheroes and villains do you know? Make a list.
3. **Which character do you want to be?** Today you are going to create your own superhero/supervillain vegetable character. Think about what your costume will look like and what your powers will be. Use the By Day and By Night character resource to draw a picture of you by day and a picture of your secret Superveggie identity by night.
4. **Superveggie character description** - Draw a picture of your superhero or supervillain character and write a description about your characters costume and super powers.
5. **Friday-** Today you will need to dress up in your Supervegetable outfit and get in to character. If you are a hero, what are you going to do today to save the world? If you are a villain, what are you going to do to cause trouble? Take photos of you posing in your costume and saving or putting vegetables and fruit in distress around your house.
