If heavy snow falls during the day and you are concerned about getting your child home, you are welcome to collect your child earlier. Please do not telephone in these circumstances, just call into school to collect the children. Phone lines do become extremely blocked, as you can imagine. It is our aim to open school every day but the safety of our children and our staff are our main considerations when making difficult decisions.
