
Summary:

- Large majority of children use devices daily;
- 75% or users are online for over an hour a day (25% more than 2 hours a day)
- YouTube is the most popular activity online by far
- Children's shows are easily most popular though many many unknown youTubers are cited
- More children have shared photos or made videos (c20%) though the content of these is unknown
- Listening to music remains FAR more popular than other online activity;
- STARZ is easily the most used APP though a small number are using Instagram and Facebook which has a 13+ age rating;
- There are a few 'individual' mentions of inappropriate games being played (Call of Duty) Fortnite is more popular and again not appropriate for primary age children;
- 75% watch online gamers whilst they are playing games; 20% contact / converse with unknown gamers
- 40% have had 'unpleasant' online experience but all are well- versed in how to manage this.
- Over 90% of children feel safe online both at home and in school.
- Alarmingly, over 40% say their bedroom is the primary place where they are online at home.

Impact:


- Although we are using STARZ less in school, many children are still using this as a means of communicating with one another;
- Older children well aware of safety issues that may arise if we start to use Chromebooks as a teaching medium in school.
- There is an ongoing need to keep children informed of safe behaviours online and how to manage situations that make them feel uncomfortable.
- We should promote optimum levels of online activity for children as some seem to be spending a disproportionately large amount of their spare time online.
- Informing parents of online safety issues remains important.




How I go online: 1: Which of these have you got at home?


How I go online: 2 Tick the ones you use every day
















Keeping Safe: 16: Have you ever had something happen online that was not very nice?
