This term, Wren Class will take one giant leap...

Our English work will centre around the book Bob, Man on the Moon. We will look at the structure of this story and write our own versions.

The children will also create persuasive posters, fact files and shape poems.

In maths, we will focus on place value initially and then move on to addition and subtraction. <u>Click here</u> to find our calculation policy.

In science, the children will look at what a scientist does and uses of everyday materials. We will look at the suitability of materials for particular uses.



In history, we will find out about the 1969 moon landing and people instrumental to our understanding of space.

To support our work, we will be using a variety of books including

Counting on Katherine.

In art and design, the children will explore street art and look at works by Mr Doodle, Banksy and Keith Haring.

In DT, the children will look at simple mechanisms and link their final pieces to our space topic.

In geography, the class will explore their understanding of place. We will recap the UK (including the surrounding seas and capital cities) and hot and cold places.

Our PSHCE unit is rights, rules and responsibilities. We will then move on to thinking about family and friends.

Our PE unit up to half term will cover fundamental skills and outdoor adventurous activity.

Mrs Hardwick will take the class for computing and RE on a Thursday afternoon. They will look at coding and in RE they will complete the unit who helps and cares?
