Ideas for writing trays - practice writing them in sand, foam, flour, soil, paint or rice. Can you think of or write sentences using these words? Example: Miss Jackson **said** **our** class was brilliant.

MAGNIFICENT MATHS - Making equal groups by sharing. Find something in your house that you can share in to groups e.g. small toys, cubes, sweets, coins, lego pieces. You will need up to 30. Count them out carefully and check you have the correct number.

Sharing activities- lets practice one together.

Share 20 shared between 2. First, take two pieces of paper and lay them out separately. Take one of your 20 items and put one on one of the pieces of paper. Then put one item on the other piece of paper. Continue putting one item on each piece of paper until they are all gone. If you have shared equally you should have 10 sweets on each piece of paper. **So.... 20 shared equally between 2 equals 10.**

Now try some on your own. If you need help ask your parent to email Miss Jackson.

1. 16 shared between 4

2. 25 shared between 5

3. 30 shared between 6

Helpful hint - check you have the correct number of items for each challenge before you start.
