Topic/Writing activities for this week:

- 1. This week we are looking at a new text... The Gingerbread Man by Mara Alperin. Watch the story using this <u>link</u>. Imagine you were to make your own gingerbread man. What would they look like? Use the attached resource to design your own version.

- 2. We are going to be making gingerbread in school this week. For that, we need to following instructions. Last week we learnt about verbs which are action words. When writing instructions we use something called imperative verbs. These are sometimes known as bossy verbs. They are verbs that tell you what to do. We can also use them when writing sentences. Look at the Little Miss Bossy imperative verbs resource. Think of and write down sentences using some of the verbs you see on the sheet.
- 3. We are making gingerbread today. Maybe you can make some at home. Follow the instructions for the recipe attached. Can you spot any bossy verbs?
- 4. Today we are going to write instructions for making gingerbread. Think about the things you had to do. What bossy verbs could you use? Use the template attached to write 4 simple instructions and draw a picture for each thing that you did.


