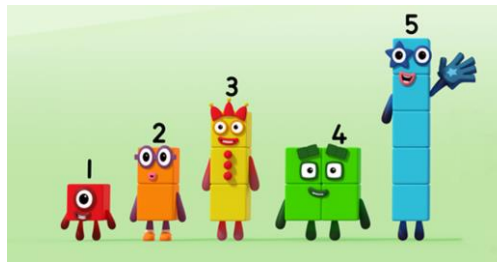

Complete the maths challenges at the bottom of the signpost. If you get them right, try this one here to test your reasoning skills.

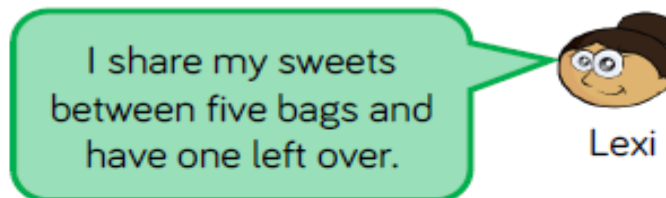
Each child has the same amount of sweets. The amount of sweets they have is less than 20.

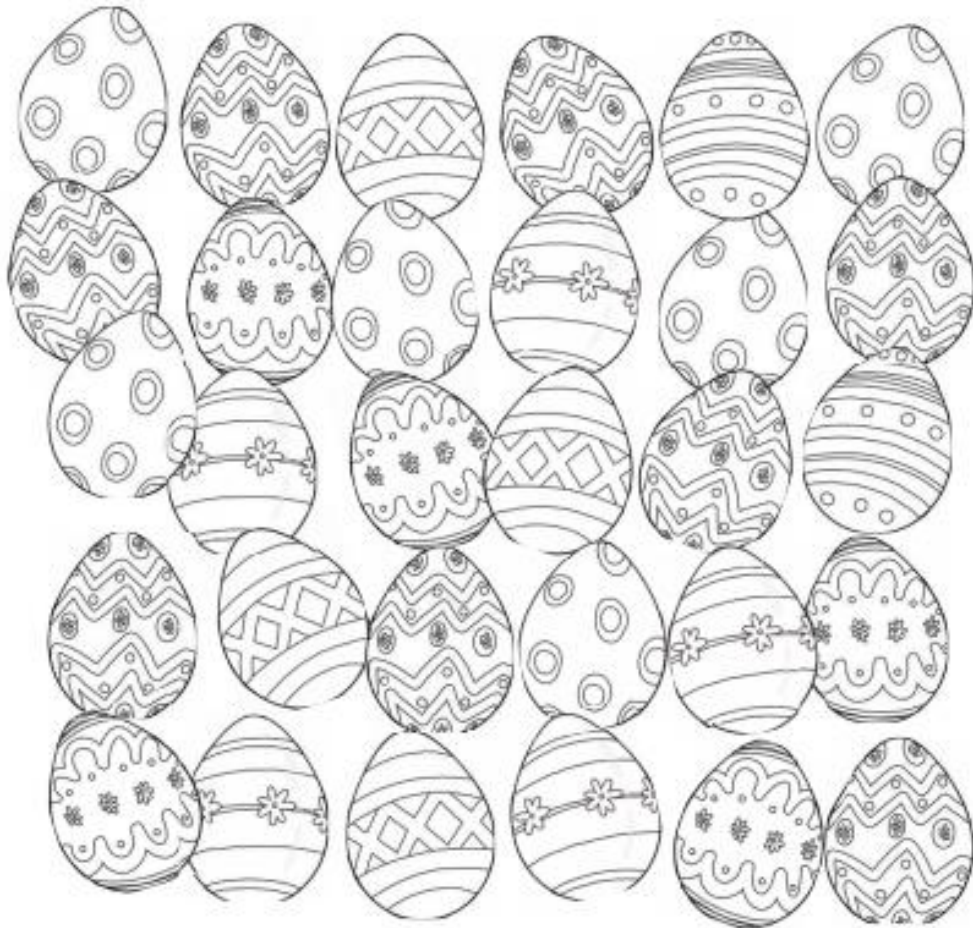
