Entry Point: After reading Yucky Worms, we will make our own worm house. We will be writing diary entries every week in order to report on what we see happening.

English	<i>We will explore and write a variety of poems. We will develop writing skills for simple riddles (Who am I?) and free verse. We will introduce singular and plural - bush / bushes. We will begin to spell words using -ed, ing, er and -est and we will use the prefix un-. We will continue to develop our skills in writing instructions and fact files.</i>
Maths	<i>We will be finishing our measure unit, specifically looking at capacity and volume. We will be covering sharing (division) and fractions for this half term. We will recognise, find and name a half as two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. We will recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.</i>
Science	<i>Plants Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees. Identify and recognise seasonal changes - spring in to summer</i>
Art	<i>We will be focusing on the land artist Andy Goldsworthy, exploring and creating patterns using a variety of natural materials. We will continue to develop our use of colour and texture by painting our own version of one of Andy's pieces of work.</i>

RE	<i>Stories and symbols, thinking about key stories in various religions.</i>





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Music	<i>Our unit is called My Imagination. We will be using chime bars and glockenspiels to play along with the main song, along with learning the words to the song.</i>
