Weather Adventures

Entry Point: It's getting a bit chilly out there! The weather is changing and autumn has arrived.

WOW Activity: Autumn and firework art/craft. Remembrance Day activity. Decoration day.

English:

- o Spell words containing each of the phonemes already taught.
- o Spell common exception words.
- o Use letter names to distinguish between alternative spellings of the same sound.
- o Write from memory simple sentences dictated by the teacher.
- o Composing a sentence orally before writing it.
- o Writing simple sentences.
- o Know how words combine to make sentences.
- o Leaving spaces between words.
- o Punctuating sentences using CLs and full stops.
- o Capital letters for names and places

Swift Class will continue our daily phonic sessions and shared reading sessions.

Maths: We will continue with our work on addition and subtraction within 10. We will also explore 2D and 3D shapes, looking at circles, rectangles, squares, triangles, cuboids, cubes, pyramids and spheres.

Science: The children will be learning about seasonal changes in the weather. The children will develop their skills and knowledge of scientific enquiry. We will be looking at the effects of seasonal change on animals, humans and the length of our day, as well as weather patterns.







Geography: We will be identifying seasonal daily weather patterns in UK and hot and cold areas, looking specifically at the Polar regions and countries on the Equator.

Art & Design: We will be using paint and craft to explore important seasonal events
