PHONICS Shove-Penny Phonics

You need- a ball/beanbag/plastic plate or bowl, masking tape/chalk

1. Mark 6 horizontal lines on the floor far enough apart that you can write a word/letter pattern in each space. *If you can't write on the floor put these on paper.* Each player needs a scorecard.

2. Take turns to roll the ball/beanbag/plastic plate towards the tramlines. If the object stops within a tramline, write down the word on your scorecard. First person to write all the words.

Works well with chn of different abilities as can use different words/letters/shapes on different sides of the lines!

Maths - Easter I spy and count

You need- copy of the ispy sheet (either printed or be able to see this on a screen, pencil and paper

1. Look at the sheet and count the number of each item.
2. How many hot cross buns and lambs?
3. What is the total number of chicks and chocolate bars?
4. Find the total number of Easter bunnies and easter eggs.

What other questions could you do?

Use the techniques we've practised this week- cake tin addition, number line, using objects, accurate formation.
